

WEST STAND EXIT 7 (TOWARDS THE LEFT OF THE BLACK GATES & RECEPTION). This entrance is for Players and Team Managers only. You will need to make sure each player has all equipment (water bottle, kit, boots, snacks etc) with them as players and spectators will be seated separately in the stadium. All teams must arrive in kit – no changing rooms are available. Team Managers are responsible for players once they are in they are in the stadium and the tournament begins. (PLEASE DO NOT ARRIVE LATER THAN YOUR STATED TIME).

You will be greeted at the registration desk by Precision Pass staff who will provide GOLD wristbands for each player and coach. This wristband must be worn at all times during the event for security purposes. You will then be escorted into the player seating area where your team will be allocated a dedicated row(s).

Spectator Information


The spectator entrance is at the **WEST STAND EXIT 4 (TOWARDS THE RIGHT OF THE BLACK GATES AND RECEPTION)**. You will be greeted at the spectator entrance desk by Precision Pass staff. All spectators must purchase a WHITE wristband (£4 entry and babies under 2 free) for access into the stands. This wristband must be worn at all times during the event for security purposes. Programmes will be available to purchase for £4 on the day.





Important Points

- **SEATING.** Teams and Spectators will be seated separately in the stadium. Spectators must not access any players areas (tunnel, players seating stands, pitchside) at any time for safeguarding reasons. Teams must occupy their dedicated seating row for the tournament. Spectators will be able to watch all matches from the left of the West Stand. Coaches should obtain items (clothing, lunch etc) from parents if necessary.

 By attending and participating in this event, you accept the terms outlined in the disclaimer.
- **PITCHSIDE ACCESS.** Players and Coaches only will be allowed pitchside for matches, tunnel lineups, changing room tours and medal ceremonies. Each team can have a maximum of 3 coaches pitchside with their players.
- **ARRIVAL.** Teams must arrive in kit (tracksuits are fine). There are no changing facilities available at the stadium. Do not bring any items which require storage



(i.e pushchairs etc) as no storage facilities are available at the stadium. To prevent crowding at the stadium, you must arrive at your Arrival Time stated in this Welcome Pack.

- DEPARTURE. As other age groups will be playing after your team, we kindly
 ask that you leave the stadium promptly once your team's medal ceremony is
 complete. You will be able to mix with the rest of your team once you are off
 site.
- **CONDUCT.** The objective of this tournament is to provide young footballers with the special opportunity of playing inside a Premier League stadium. We acknowledge this brings a flurry of emotions but we kindly request that all attendees from your team (players, coaches, spectators) are mindful of their behaviour & cooperative on the day to ensure everyone has an enjoyable experience ©.

WHAT TO BRING.

All players should arrive in match kit. A different coloured shirt/bibs should also be brought along in the case of a kit clash. No changing rooms are available.	All players MUST wear appropriate footwear to be allowed on the pitch. These include football boots with studs, blades or moulds.	Match balls will be provided by Precision Pass. - WHAT TO AVOID.

Please avoid bringing too many bulky items/bags, as from past experience, it's best to keep your team light and mobile. There will be no storage facilities at the stadium. To help speed up bag searches with security, aim to use clear and see through boxes/bags for your lunch and other items. Please do not bring valuable items, items which require storage (i.e pushchairs) and large cameras which require tripod stands. Strictly no alcohol and smoking/vaping at the stadium







Tournament Format

Managers Meeting

Before your team's first game, Precision Pass will conduct a short meeting with team managers to brief you on how the day will work and reconfirm any important information. This is a good opportunity to ask any quick questions.

Tunnel Walkout

Once the managers meeting is complete, your team will be led pitchside in a specific order. The big moment will arrives as your team will make their way into the tunnel and walk out onto the pitch with the Sunderland matchday anthem playing over the stadium speakers!

Warm Ups

Each team will receive 3-4 minutes of warm up time prior to kicking off. Your team may want to do some light stretching or some quick ball drills to get the muscles warm and adrenaline flowing!

Football

The main pitch will be split into 4 smaller pitches (2 in each half). All teams will play 4 games of 15 minutes in duration – a total of 60 minutes playing time on the pitch.

4 teams (1x 4 teams)

- Cup format
- 3 group games
- 1 finals match

8 teams (2 x 4 teams)

- Cup + Plate format
- 3 group games
- 1 finals match

12 teams (4 x 3 teams)

- Cup + Plate format
- 2 group games
- 1 semi-final
- 1 final

16 teams (4 x 4 teams)

- Cup + Plate format (x2)
- 3 group games
- 1 finals match






Tournament Format

Pitchside Protocols

Once your match is complete, your team must promptly leave pitchside and take a seat in the stand until your next game. Pitchside must be kept clear at all times unless your team is playing.

No equipment which will impale the pitch (i.e. veo cameras, tripod stands, slalom poles etc) is



allowed pitchside. Team managers/coaches should remove any warm up balls, cones etc and each player should remove their own water bottle from the pitch once their match is complete.

Remember – this is a youth football tournament so please be mindful of your team's behaviour so everyone can enjoy their special stadium experience.

Changing Room Tour

Each team will be allocated a time slot during the day for a changing room tour. This will be given to you at registration on the event day. At your given time, you will be escorted in by tournament staff for a 5 minute tour and photo opportunity.





Additional information

Medal Ceremony

Once your team has completed all fixtures, they will partake in a special pitchside medal ceremony to commemorate the day. Every player will receive a medal regardless of where their team finishes. This will be presented on stage along with a team photo opportunity. A trophy will be awarded to Cup winners.

Programmes

There will be official tournament programmes available to purchase at the stadium for the price of £4. Included in the programme is all team fixtures and the full event schedule. Each team and player name will also be listed in the programme making it a great souvenir of the day. Each team will receive a complimentary copy handed to the Team Manager.

Food & Drink

Kiosk 24, located in the West Stand, will be open to purchase food & drink throughout the day – this is operated by Sunderland AFC and will be serving a limited selection of food. Precision Pass have no control on what will be served or the prices. You may wish to bring water / soft drinks and snacks with you. **ALCOHOL & SMOKING/VAPING IS NOT PERMITTED AT THE STADIUM**.

There is ample car parking available at the stadium in the RED car park. Address: Stadium of Light, Sunderland, Tyne & Wear, SR5 1SU. The stadium entrance for players and spectators is nearest to the Red parking and black gates.

Tournament Rules

1. Age groups are as of the 2024/25 current season.

16s. Precision Pass will provide match balls.

- **2. Teams.** U7-U8 will play 5v5, U9-U14 will play 7v7 and U15/16 will play 6v6.
- **3. Equipment**. All jewellery must be removed before entering the field of play. Players must wear shinpads. Trainers, Astro boots and football boots are allowed. However, the suitability and safety of all equipment is at the discretion of the referee who will judge according to the prevailing conditions. The ball will be Size 3 for U7s U9s and Size 4 for U10s U14s and Size 5 for U15-
- **4. Colour clash.** In the event of a colour clash the team named first will be required to change their shirts, wear them inside out or wear distinguishing bibs.
- **5. Choice of ends.** The team named first in the schedule will have choice of ends. Their opponents will kick-off.
- **6. The match ball.** The match ball will be provided by Precision Pass
- **7. Substitutions.** Roll-on roll-off substitutions are allowed at all age groups but they can only be made with the referee's permission and when the ball is not in play.
- **8. Referees.** The referee's decision is final. Precision Pass will not over-rule any decision.
- **9. Goalkeepers.** At U7s and 8s, goalkeepers may fly-kick the ball out of their hands. For all other age groups, the goal keeper must release the ball by hand to another player. A goalkeeper cannot roll the ball to himself and clear with his feet. Infringement of this rule will result in an indirect free kick. Players are allowed in the goal area and the goalkeeper allowed out of the area. Goal kicks are taken from the goal line. U7-U10 players must retreat to the halfway line for opposition goal kicks. U11-U16 players must be at least 3 metres away from the ball for all free kicks and goal kicks. The goalkeeper is not allowed to pick the ball up as a result of a deliberate back-pass at any age group.
- **10. Match Time.** The duration of matches is 15 minutes with no half-times.
- **11. Klaxon.** A klaxon will be sounded over the stadium PA to indicate to the referees when to start and stop the game. This sound is not used in place of the referees whistle, thus all teams should ensure that they play to the referees whistle, not the klaxon.
- **12. Scoring.** 3 points for a win, 1 point for a draw.
- **13. Drawn matches.** Where Semi Finals and Finals matches are Drawn, they will be resolved by the taking of penalty kicks. The team named first in the schedule will shoot first. Each team will take 3 penalties alternately, using 3 different players from

the team on the field at the final whistle. If the scores are level teams will continue to take alternate penalties, firstly by the remaining players and then in the same order as before, until one team scores and the other team fails. Only players on the field at the final whistle may take penalties.

- **14. Red Cards.** Any player sent off by the referee will be barred from playing in their team's next tournament match. Referees will enter the names of any offending players in the match result card.
- **15. Off-Side.** There are no off-sides.
- **16. Penalty Area.** The penalty area will be clearly marked.
- **17. Throw-In.** A throw-in will be taken if the ball passes over the touch line.
- **18. Reporting results.** The referee will be responsible for reporting the score to the tournament organisers.
- **19. Normal Rules.** Except for these provisions, the laws of the Football Association apply.

IMPORTANT

This is a youth football tournament with the aim of creating special memories. To help maintain an enjoyable experience for everybody attending on the day, please ensure that you and all players, coaches, spectators from your team are mindful of their behaviour.

Referees recruited for this tournament are all qualified with County FA's. We remind team managers and players to respect referees and be mindful of their conduct.
